Members of the Board met previously with the extension staff to develop ideas to increase the Association's community outreach and discuss maintenance needs of the Botanical Garden. As a possible way to increase funding from the county the membership was urged to diligently submit volunteer hours and contacts made to the Extension website. Appreciation by the County Commissioners for the Botanical Garden and the visitors it draws could yield needed funds to assist in its maintenance. **Maryann Horgan** contacted the Chamber of Commerce who will begin to include information regarding the Botanical Garden in its publications.

The BCMGVA has contributed 5,967 volunteer hours year to date, just short of the annual goal set at 6,000 hours. President Horgan recognized **John Walters** with a 'Rookie of the Year' award for having volunteered 193 hours. **Sam Marshall** gave a brief tutorial on accessing the Extension Website and how to post contacts and volunteer hours.

Sandra McIver met to discuss development of a Japanese Garden. More members are needed for both gardens.

Plant Sale Committee - Vicki Fuhrmann announced the on-line plant sale posted \$19,680 in sales. Volunteers

are still needed to assist in unloading plants on September 26 and 27. Members were urged to fill the time slots

remaining for volunteer hours during the sale. 'Pass-Along Plants' for the sale may be dropped off any days

before the sale with Vicki.

Webmaster - Amanda Kiel requested members report to her any out of date material on the 'Weekly Weeder'

as well as the website.

Extension Coordinators Reports and Updates

lower the fee. No other bids were submitted.
