A House Calls team will accompany you on a one-hour tour of your garden to observe, assess and answer questions. They will examine your lawn and gardens for problems you may or may not see.

After the visit, you will receive a detailed report on the team's observations and suggestions on how to achieve your goals for your landscape.

#### **Become a Master Gardener**

Master Gardener Volunteers work with the NC Cooperative Extension to provide the public with unbiased, research-based information on gardens, lawns and landscapes.

Under the guidance of Coopertive Extension agents, volunteers complete a 40-hour training program, pass an examination, and complete a 40-hour internship. To remain active in the program, volunteers must log a minimum of 40 hours of volunteer service each year.

Brunswick County Master Gardeners can be found volunteering in a variety of ways:

- \* Answering questions at Farmers Markets;
- \* Planning and managing Plant Sales;
- \* Making 'House Calls' to homeowners;
- \* Teaching 'A Day in the Yard' classes;

- \* Working with Juvenile Restitution programs.
